WHAT IS CANSKATE?

The **CanSkate** program is Canada's only national Learn-to-Skate program for skaters ages 3 and up. It was developed by experts in the field to teach the fundamentals of skating in a progressive and sequential manner. Designed to give skaters the basic skating skills required for hockey, figure skating and recreational skating.

CanSkaters strive to achieve Skate Canada Stages: Stage 1, Stage 2, Stage 3, Stage 4, Stage 5, Stage 6

Please note: The letters A, B, C, D, E, F, G reflect the lesson the CanSkater is on, not the level they are skating at.

WHAT IS CANSKATE PLUS?

The **CanSkate Plus** program is geared towards skaters who have completed Stage 5 or higher in the CanSkate program and are interested in continuing onto Figure Skating. Classes are 60 minutes in length, skaters will receive; 15 minutes of stroking, two 15 minute group lessons per session and 15 minutes of free skate to practise what they have learned.

★ Upon completion of every session each skater will receive a Progress Report and Ribbon



★ Skate Canada Badges will be distributed each time the skater passes a Stage

ADMINISTRATION INFORMATION

Code of Conduct: It is the responsibility of every skater and parent/guardian to be aware of, and abide by the Policies, Rules and Codes of Conduct which are posted on the website and arena bulletin board.

Multiple Sibling Discount: A 10% discount will be offered to the 3rd or subsequent sibling within a family when all skaters register and pay in full at the same time.

Multiple Day Discount: Register the same skater for additional days in the same session and receive a \$20.00 discount.

Pro-Rating: Joining the program late, a pro-rated amount is provided if space permits.

Refunds: All programs are non-refundable. Refund requests for medical or other exceptional reasons must be made in writing and be supported by a doctor's note. The Executive Board reserves the right to deny refunds. A \$25.00 administrative charge will be applied to approved refunds.

Returned Payments: NSF cheques will be subject to the administration fee of \$25.00.

No Make Up Sessions: Due to maximum restrictions on the ice, and to ensure safety, all skaters are only permitted to skate during their regularly scheduled ice-time.

Fundraising: The ASC is a not-for-profit club, support from STARSkate families is required with a one time, seasonal, mandatory non-refundable fundraising amount of \$50.00/family (CanSkate & CanSkate Plus exempt).

Volunteer Commitment: In order for our skaters to enjoy a successful year and for families to enjoy the best possible rates, we ask that all parents of skaters be available to volunteer in an area of their choosing, or as required by the ASC's specific needs.

Publicity: ASC registered skaters name and/or pictures may be published and appear in our advertising, on our website, and in local publications.

ASC Spirit Day: Saturday, March 11, 2017
CanSkater can invite a friend or parent to join them on the ice! All CanSkate safety regulations are to be adhered to. i.e.: CSA helmets are mandatory. Check the ASC bulletin board and website for more information closer to the date. *The Aurora Skating Club does not supply helmets or skates.*

Skate Canada Fee: All payments must include a mandatory, non-refundable Skate Canada membership fee not included in our rates. This annual membership is valid from Sept.1, 2016 to Aug. 31, 2017.
